

StuCo Responsibilities

President (8th Grade):

- Write announcements and have them approved by the sponsor.

Vice President (8th Grade):

- Fill the president's responsibilities if absent.
- Coordinate activities.
- Assist other officers/ reps in their duties.
- Attend alternating Wednesday morning StuCo meetings and other activities.

Secretary (8th Grade):

- Take attendance of officers, reps, and members.
- Take notes at every meeting.
- Attend alternating Wednesday morning StuCo meetings and other activities.

7th Grade Representatives (Two 7th Grade Officers):

- Assist officers in organizing and leading events.
- Delegate tasks to members.
- Attend alternating Wednesday morning StuCo meetings and other activities.

7th & 8th Grade Members:

- Attend alternating Wednesday morning StuCo meetings and other activities when you are able to do so.
- Support officers in organizing and promoting events.
- (Elections will not be held for members; anyone can join as a member!)



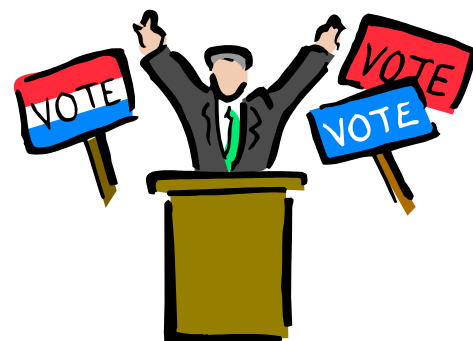
StuCo Election Rules and Guidelines

Dates to Remember:

Wed, Sept 5 th	-Informational meeting in room 241 at 8:05am.
Wed, Sept 5 th – Wed, Sept 12 th	-Sign up on the bulletin board. -Turn in Candidate Agreement form to the main office. -Submit 1 copy of your speech (<i>8th grade candidates only</i>)
Thurs, Sept 13 th OR Fri, Sept 14 th	-Record speeches in Room 241 before/after school. (<i>8th grade candidates only</i>) -Record species in Room 241 before school. (<i>8th grade candidates only</i>)
Wed, Sept 12 th – Wed, Sept 19 th	-Hang only posters approved by a sponsor.
Wed, Sept 19 th	-8 th grade speeches will be shown during 4 th hour immediately followed by 7 th & 8 th grade voting.
Thurs, Sept 20 th	-Candidates must remove posters by 8:30am. -All candidates will be contacted with results.
Fri, Sept 21 st	-Elected officers will be announced.

- ✦ Each candidate may put up 6 posters (24" X 28")
- ✦ All posters must be approved by Mrs. Andrade (counseling office) or Mrs. Ballard (Room 241)
- ✦ Posters **MAY BE PLACED** on windows. **Bring your own tape!!**
- ✦ **INAPPROPRIATE POSTERS WILL BE REMOVED!**
- ✦ All posters must be removed by the candidates by 8:30am on Thurs, Sept 20th.
- ✦ Buttons, pamphlets, candy, etc are NOT allowed.
- ✦ No more than \$25 can be spent on campaign materials.
